All Read Right Project Sites, Elementary through High School, 2012 School Year

The following data for approximately 2,750 students was generated by all K-12 school sites that performed pre- and post-program testing with a norm-referenced standardized test (Gates-MacGinitie Test of Reading) when students entered and exited a classroom Read Right Reading Intervention Program. Read Right Systems agrees it is important to monitor individual student progress, as well as overall program effectiveness. For that reason, we recommend this summative testing for all schools currently under contract with us. Classroom teachers and aides administer the tests. We have not removed any student data from this report. Data for special education students (SpEd) and English language learners (ELL) is included in the all-student composite results.
